



Spring Recycling Collection Event

April 6, 2024 9am to 3pm

at Hazelwood Elementary



Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....

- **TIRES:** Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$3.00 for extra tires off rim. \$6.00 for all passenger tires on rims. \$10 for each large truck tire and \$20 for each truck tire on rim (*cash only*). No oversized tires accepted.
- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, motorcycle, and sealed lead acid batteries accepted.
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell alkaline batteries. **No rechargeable, cell phone, or nicad batteries accepted. Lithium-ion batteries, like tool and vape batteries, will not be accepted. Visit Call2Recycle.org for more battery recycling options.**
- **CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENT SHREDDING:** Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Limit 4 file-size boxes. No exceptions. [Visit atg.wa.gov/community-shred-events](http://atg.wa.gov/community-shred-events) for more paper shredding options.
- **STYROFOAM BLOCKS AND PACKING PEANUTS** - White styrofoam blocks. Packing peanuts (any color). All materials must be clean and dry. No urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation. Expanded polystyrene only. Look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol. Packing peanuts: please keep in box or bag.
- **ELECTRONIC/COMPUTER EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones (**remove personal information**). Computers and computer monitors (**no charge**), mouse, keyboards, tablet computers, and e-readers.
- **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (no charge). For free regular collection of computers, monitors, and TVs, visit CycleWA.org.
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. \$10 (*cash only*).
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. \$25 (*cash only*).
- **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Household appliances, auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), metal lawn chairs, stoves, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. \$5 (*cash only*) will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating. Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. **No light fixture ballasts or sealed drums accepted. Any item that contains gas or oil will be rejected.**
- **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** \$35 (*cash only*) will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer. \$35 (*cash only*) will be charged for each household air conditioner. **Please be prepared to pay at event entrance.**
- **MATTRESSES/BOX SPRINGS:** Mattresses and box springs any size. \$35 (*cash only*) for each mattress and \$35 (*cash only*) for each box spring. **Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.**

NO CARDBOARD: Please recycle cardboard in your curbside recycling bin.

PLEASE NOTE: HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING will not be accepted. This material can be self hauled to donation locations in the local area. CALL FIRST TO CONFIRM LOCATIONS ARE OPEN AND ACCEPTING MATERIAL.



Call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit ecyclewa.org to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. Residents may drop off TVs, computer monitors, desktop and laptop computers, tablets, e-readers, and portable DVD players at no charge at the following locations: Goodwill Renton Store (3210 NE Sunset Blvd, Renton, WA 98056, 425-264-0277) and E-Recycle on Mercer Island (7835 SE 30th Street, Mercer Island, WA 98040, 206-230-8188). Call first to confirm hours. Drop off locations may change and quantities accepted may be limited. Note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Events. **Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.**

DON'T BRING!



These household wastes:

- No household goods or clothing
- No scrap wood, yard debris
- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No furniture
- No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass

These hazardous wastes:

- NO MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, AND ANTIFREEZE
- No oil based paint/solvents
- No pesticides/herbicides
- No solvents and thinners
- No household chemicals

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to the hazardous waste collection site in Factoria. The Factoria site is located at 13800 SE 32nd Street, Bellevue. The site is open 8 am - 4 pm Tuesday - Friday and 9 am - 5 pm Saturday and Sunday (except major holidays). There is a limit of 25 gallons of gasoline and a limit of 50 gallons of other automotive fluids per trip. Containers should be labeled and must be 5 gallons or smaller. Customers can have gas containers back upon request. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned. No latex paint is accepted. See www.paintcare.org/wa for more information on paint collection.
